

TRANSNATIONAL LEARNING ACTIVITY IN DARMSTADT

10-14 December 2018 Project "Motivating young Europeans", number 2017-1-DE02-KA202-004129

The learning activity was held from 10th to 14th December 2018 in Darmstadt together with the fifth meeting of the project partners. The host institution of vocational school HEMS (Heinrich-Emanuel-Merck Schule) organised a short training for 11 foreign students from 3 vocational schools: our school, Instituto di Istruzione Superiore di Stato from Brescia in Italy and PIKC Liepajas Valsts Tehnikums from Liepaja in Latvia. Four Polish students from an IT class attended this short training. Two trainees went to the Technical University and two others had a training in an IT company - mg.softtech Gmbh.

On the first day students went to their companies to have a training. They had lunches in the companies but dinners were eaten together with the teachers.

Besides the training they had some cultural and social activities. In the afternoon of the first day they went to a meeting with the deputy mayor of Darmstadt. In one evening there was some dinner in a hut at the Christmas Market where they tasted traditional "Wurst" and hot "Rotwein", in another there was a huge dinner party in the Auerbach Castle. Before the dinner there a knights competition in which one of our students took part.

On the last day of the meeting all the students went to school to prepare presentations about their training experience and to evaluate their learning activity. After showing the presentations to the teachers and organisers all the students were handed in certificates confirming their training in the company.

Finally, all the students filled in online evaluation form of their training activity. However, their stay wasn't so perfectly organised because two of our students had to pay for their lunches.
