

TRANSNATIONAL LEARNING ACTIVITY IN PLOCK

The learning activity was held from 7th to 12th April 2019 in Plock together with the sixth meeting of the project partners. Our school organised a 5-day training for 4 foreign students from 2 vocational schools: HEMS from Darmstadt in Germany and PIKC Liepajas Valsts Tehnikums from Liepaja in Latvia. All the trainees went to REJS Company in Rypin.

All the students arrived on Sunday because they started their training on Monday morning at 6 a.m.

On the first day students went to the company to have safety instructions first. Then they had a tour of the company and after that they started the proper training. Every day they had lunches in the hotel after returning from the training.

The organiser in the company Ms Wioletta Wojenska (personal assistant) prepared some activities for every afternoon. On Tuesday afternoon they visited Stanislaw Kostka Church, watched the glass windows - the biggest in Europe and went to the glass window workshop of Elzbieta Bednarska. On Thursday afternoon they visited the town hall and had a meeting with the mayor Pawel Grzybowski. They also visited the Police Station and the Fire Department in Rypin. Thus the students had some cultural and social activities during the training.

On the last day all the students joined the teachers in our school. They were to prepare presentations about their training experience and to evaluate their learning activity. While preparing the photos they were handed in certificates confirming their training in the company and some souvenirs. Later they told the teachers about the benefits from their learning stay in REJS Company in Rypin showing some photos from the training. After that all the students filled in online evaluation form of their training activity.
